**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF APALACHICOLA, FLORIDA
ADOPTING THE FRANKLIN COUNTY LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Apalachicola is vulnerable to the human and economic costs of natural, technological and societal disasters, and

WHEREAS, the Apalachicola City Commission recognizes the importance of reducing or eliminating those vulnerabilities for the overall good and welfare of the community, and

WHEREAS, the City of Apalachicola has been an active participant in the Franklin County Local Mitigation Strategy Task Force, which has established a comprehensive, coordinated planning process to eliminate or decrease these vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, these proposed projects and programs have been incorporated into the initial edition of the Franklin County Local Mitigation Strategy that has been prepared and issued for consideration and implementation by the communities of Franklin County.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
APALACHICOLA, FLORIDA THAT:**

The Apalachicola City Commission adopts the *Franklin County Local Mitigation Strategy* to reflect the current need and citizens desire to identify and implement hazard mitigation initiatives that will reduce the County's susceptibility to numerous hazards. And, at the appropriate time, the Commission will develop and submit funding proposals to appropriate agencies to implement the hazard mitigation initiatives identified in the *Franklin County Local Mitigation Strategy*.
