### SPECIAL NEED SHELTER EVACUEE INSTRUCTION SHEET

## Welcome to the Special Needs Care Shelter.

We know this is a difficult situation for you. The staff wants to make your stay at the shelter as pleasant as possible. The following rules have been established to help accomplish this.

- 1. All individuals staying in the shelter must sign in.
- 2. A designated space with cots and/or beds will be provided to special needs evacuees first; caregivers will be provided cots and/or beds as needed/ available.
- 3. A nurse will meet with you and discuss your special needs and assist you in meeting whatever special health care needs you have.
- 4. Food and water will be provided. If you are on a special diet please inform the nurse.
- 5. You are welcome to walk around but when requested please return to your designated space.
- 6. The staff will keep you informed regarding the disaster event as information becomes available.
- 7. For your safety please remain within the shelter.
- 8. Absolutely No Smoking within the building. This is necessary because Oxygen, which is very flammable, may be in use.
- 9. Children in the shelter must be under the control of an adult at all times. Check with the nurse about the assigned children's plan area.
- 10. Evacuees are responsible for their own personal belongings and valuables. No special storage facilities can be provided.
- 11. Please do not ask to use the "house" phones, as they must be reserved for official business and emergencies.
- 12. No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, explosive devices or firearms are allowed in the Shelter.
- 13. Courtesy is expected at all times. Disorderly conduct is prohibited and will be handled by security officials.
- 14. NO PETS except Seeing Eye dogs or handicap assistance animals will be allowed in the shelter.

\_\_\_\_\_ Medical supplies to last at least 96 hours (if you are insulin dependent, please put insulin in small cooler or insulated bag.

\_\_\_\_\_ Prescription Drugs to last at least 96 hours in original bottles

\_\_\_\_\_ Extra sets of clothes

\_\_\_\_\_ Sturdy Shoes

\_\_\_\_\_ Rain coat / poncho / umbrella

- \_\_\_\_\_ Extra pair of glasses / sun glasses
- \_\_\_\_\_ Washcloth and towels
- \_\_\_\_\_ Toiletries
- \_\_\_\_\_ Pillow / blanket / sleeping bag
- \_\_\_\_\_ Games / books
- List of important people with phone numbers and addresses, including insurance agent, family members and physicians
- Photos of property (if not in a safety deposit box or with a friend not in the path of the storm)

\_\_\_\_\_ Portable, battery operated radio

#### Instructions:

- □ Lock your house.
- □ Shut off water, gas and electricity
- Take care of animals. Remember: Animals CANNOT be brought to the Special Needs Shelter.
- Post a rainproof note of appreciable size telling others when you left and where you are going.

# YOUR SPECIAL NEEDS SHELTER SUPPY KIT SHOULD INCLUDEí .

- 3-day supply of nonperishable food, if you are on a special diet and can not eat the meals the Red Cross will provide
- Prescription medicines in original bottles, along with any other medication, for at least 72 hours,
- If you are insulin dependent, please put insulin in small cooler or insulated bag.
- Oxygen tank portable and concentrator and any other supplies needed for his or her care
- With no power, banks may be closed, checks and credit cards unaccepted, and ATMøs cannot operate, so please have some cash on hand
- Photo ID, proof of residency and insurance cards and other important documents
- Personal toiletries and (wash cloth and towel)
- Blanket/sleeping bag and pillow
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Some bottled water for the travel to the shelter
- o Plan of Care
- Extra clothing and shoes

Store these supplies in sturdy, water resistant, easy to carry containers, such as back packs or duffel bags. Keep important papers and family documents in a weather proof container.
