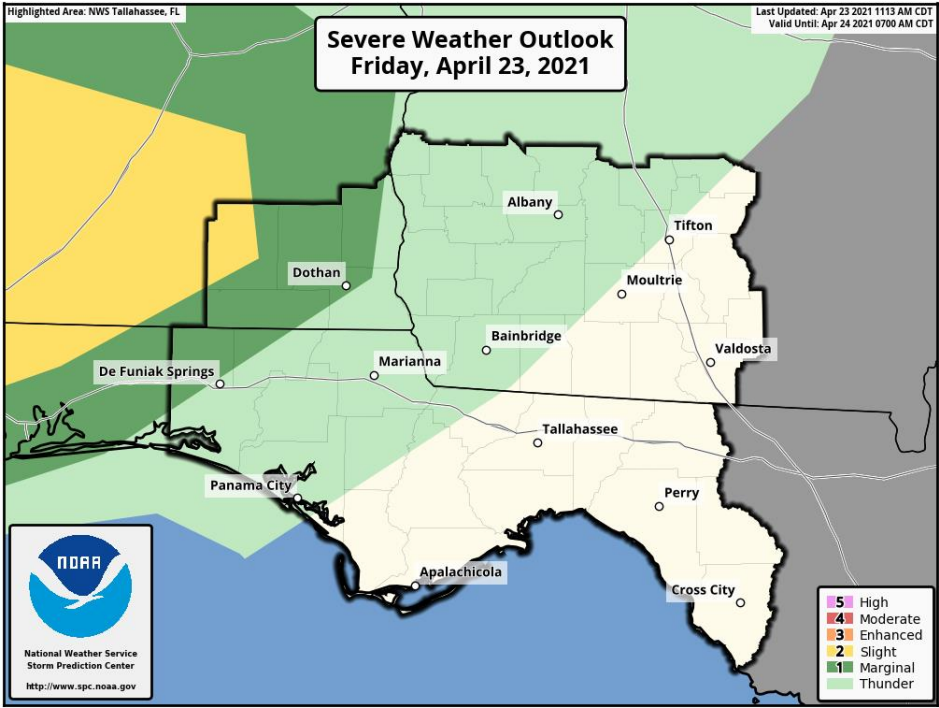




# National Weather Service Tallahassee, Florida

## Severe Weather Expected Late Tonight through Saturday Evening



### Overview:

A strong late-season storm system will move through the Southeast, bringing the potential for severe weather across the region, especially on Saturday.

### Late tonight:

A few strong to severe storms may approach Southeast Alabama and portions of the Florida Panhandle before sunrise.

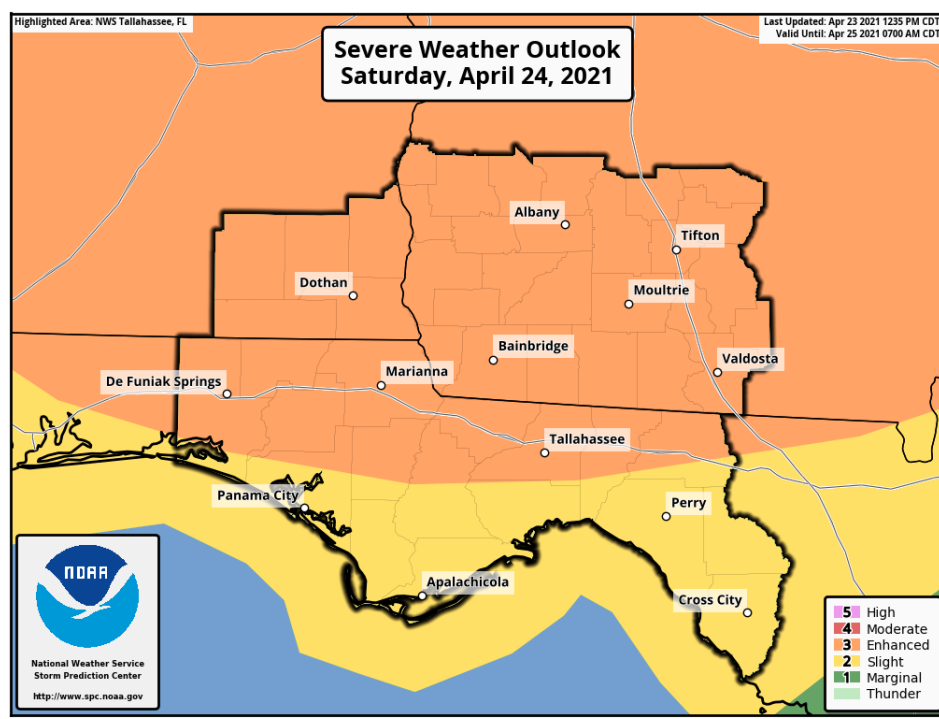
Main threats include gusty winds, hail, and a brief tornado.

### Saturday:

Severe weather is expected throughout the day, with multiple rounds of severe storms possible. Potential hazards include:

- Tornadoes, some significant.
- Destructive winds in excess of 70 mph.
- Large hail, some in excess of 2 inches in diameter.
- Locally heavy rainfall.

Remain alert for additional severe weather even after the first round of storms has passed!
