

POD - Water and 15 Minute Meals

Franklin County residents, if you enjoy complimentary offerings, this event is designed for you! We will be hosting a Point of Distribution (POD) exercise alongside the "Build a Bucket" initiative. This event provides the community with an opportunity to understand the logistics of distributing essential items in the aftermath of a disaster. While we hope such a scenario never occurs, this exercise will serve as valuable practice.

Attendees will receive free water and complimentary 15-Minute Chef Meals, available while supplies last. To access the POD, please enter via Highway 98 and turn onto NE 12th Street by Carrabelle City Hall. Continue straight until you reach the designated left turn, marked by white signs along the roadside to guide you.

Following the left turn, you will arrive at the front of the Old Carrabelle High School. We will allow three vehicles at a time to approach our station. Upon arriving at the distribution location, please open your trunk or the rear of your vehicle, and we will place a box of 15-Minute Chef Meals and a case of water inside.

After receiving your items, you may proceed to the parking lot, where you can attend the Build a Disaster Bucket Event or head home. Please remember that all offerings are available while supplies last, and the Build Your Disaster kit is one Bucket per household. The event will commence at 10 AM on Saturday, May 3rd, and will continue until 3 PM on the same day. We look forward to seeing everyone there!
